B and HOD PBY 2 Failed	BE IT RESOLVED THAT CDHA: AMENDS CDHA BYLAWS SECTION 7.04 DUTIES OF THE HOUSE Which read, "It shall be the annual duty of the House To adopt a budget which ensures a fiscally sound organization." The proposed change was the below: "To ensure a fiscally sound Association, review the CDHA budget presented by the Board of Trustees, and ratify or reject the presented budget as submitted. All budget adjustments proposed by delegates during the Reference Committee hearing, shall be submitted to the Board of Trustees for further consideration." Discussion ensued. Proposed change to Bylaw 2 was failed and was agreed to refer to the President.
